

DIRECTIONS

We would like you to note that using internet mapping services will not provide you with accurate directions. Please use the ones provided below to ensure an enjoyable drive!

From Calgary International Airport

- Head east on Airport Road, at the stoplight turn left onto Barlow Trail.
- Stay on Barlow Trail for approximately 1km, at the stoplight intersection at Airport Trail/90th Ave, turn left onto Airport Trail.
- Follow Airport Trail for approximately 3.5km, turn right to merge onto Deerfoot Trail North.
- Stay on Deerfoot Trail North for approximately 2.5km, take Exit 271 Stoney Trail West
- Continue on Stoney Trail for approximately 16km, merge right onto Hwy 1A/Crowchild Trail West.
- Follow Hwy 1A for approximately 18 km to Cochrane and intersection of Hwy 22 and Hwy 1A (on website location map) keep straight follow Hwy 1A heading West.
- Stay on Hwy 1A for 14km until you see the exit for Hwy 40 and The Crossing sign on the right hand side of the road (a gas plant is on the left hand side), turn right onto Hwy 40.
- Stay on Hwy 40 for 10km at which point you should see The Crossing sign on your right hand side, the driveway is approximately 300 metres after the sign on your left.
- Turn left down the gravel road and drive 2km until you reach the parking lot and see the main buildings.

From Banff/Canmore

- Take Hwy 1 Trans – Canada Hwy east until you see an exit for Hwy 22/Cochrane, take this exit and follow Hwy 22 through Cochrane.
- Once you reach the intersection of Hwy 22 and Hwy 1A (on website location map) turn left onto Hwy 1A heading west.
- Stay on Hwy 1A for 14km until you see the exit for Hwy 40 and The Crossing sign on the right hand side of the road (a gas plant is on the left hand side), turn right onto Hwy 40.
- Stay on Hwy 40 for 10km at which point you should see The Crossing sign on your right hand side, the driveway is approximately 300 metres after the sign on your left.
- Turn left down the gravel road and drive 2km until you reach the parking lot and see the main buildings.
